

US Lacrosse Membership Policy for Flower Mound Lacrosse Association

Article I Purpose

The purpose of the US Lacrosse Membership policy is to ensure that all players and coaches have insurance through US Lacrosse and thereby, protect the players, coaches and Flower Mound Lacrosse Association ("FMLA").

Article II

All participants on all teams (players and coaches) associated with FMLA must, without any exception, be a current member with US Lacrosse and that membership must be in effect for the entire season.

No player or coach will be permitted to participate in any practices, games or other activities of FMLA without being a current member with US Lacrosse.

FMLA will develop and put in place an appropriate systematic approach, which may be modified from time to time, to require participants to provide his/her current US Lacrosse membership number and expiration date as part of the FMLA registration process, verify that such players and coaches are current members of US Lacrosse and ensure ongoing compliance by participants. This systematic approach will include, at a minimum, the following:

- The registration process will require that registering players provide his/her current US Lacrosse membership number and expiration
- FMLA will appoint a Team Registrar whose job is to check that all participants (players and coaches) have provided proof of US Lacrosse membership prior to the first team practice
- Team Registrar will maintain copies (electronically or otherwise) of registration forms and verify membership status through US Lacrosse's website
- Coaches will not permit any player to participate until they are cleared by the Team Registrar
- Team Registrar will perform a mid-season spot check to determine if any players are participating on the team who are not on the verified membership list.
